# CHECKLIST FOR PARTISAN, AND INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES

Candidates for <u>county offices</u>, <u>school boards and Mohave Community College boards</u>, must file a **Candidate <u>Statement of Interest</u>** before obtaining any signatures on the Nomination Petition. [A.R.S. §§ 16-311; 16-341]

Fillable forms are available on the Elections website <a href="www.mohave.gov">www.mohave.gov</a>; select <a href="Departments">Departments</a>, then <a href="Elections">Elections</a>, and select from the navigation menu to the left of the contents page. Current <a href="Candidate">Candidate</a></a></a></a><a href="Signature Requirements">Signature Requirements</a> are available after January 2 of even numbered years. For assistance you may also contact the Elections Department at 928-753-0733.

- Nomination papers must be filed not less than 120 nor more than 150 days before the primary election.
- Primary Election Date: August 4, 2026 General Election Date: November 3, 2026
- A candidate shall register as a candidate committee, if the candidate receives contributions or makes expenditures, in any combination, of at least \$1,500.00 in connection with their candidacy. [A.R.S. §§16-905(A), (I); 16-931(A)(1)]
  - Candidate shall file a Statement of Organization with the Elections Dept. within ten (10) days after qualifying as a committee (\$1,500 threshold). This triggers the candidate's obligation to file Campaign Finance Reports.

The Elections Department processes all nomination papers presented before 5:00 p.m. the same day.

Check the Elections website <u>www.mohave.gov</u>; select <u>Departments</u>, then <u>Elections</u>, then <u>Candidate</u> <u>Signature Requirements</u>, or call 928-753-0733 after January 2nd of the election year to obtain the official number of signatures required. **The Elections Department will not call candidates with the official number of signatures required.** 

## REQUIRED FORMS ARE LISTED BELOW.

All original 2026 Candidate <u>Nomination Petitions</u>, <u>Nomination Paper</u>, <u>and Financial Disclosure</u>

<u>Statements</u> must be filed together at the Mohave County Elections Office on the following dates, to wit:

Primary Election (Partisan offices): March 9, 2026 - April 6, 2026

# 1. NOMINATION PAPER, DECLARATION OF QUALIFICATION

- Make sure to fill in each blank.
- o Print the candidate's name exactly how he or she wants it to be printed on the ballot. The candidate's last name must appear first. Nicknames are permissible as long as they do not suggest a title.
- o The form must be signed by the candidate.

#### 2. FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

- Covers the 12-month period preceding the filing. (This is a different time period from the public officer filing in January).
- Make sure to answer each question and fill in each blank.
- The candidate must sign the form.
- Financial Disclosure Statement does not apply to Title 48 Special Taxing Districts, Community College Board members, or Precinct Committeeman.

## 3. NOMINATION PETITIONS

Each Circulator is responsible for witnessing <u>ALL</u> of the signatures on the petitions they circulate. [A.R.S. §16-321]

- o Print Nomination Petitions as 1 sheet of paper, two sided.
- Before circulating any nomination petition, make sure that a Candidate Statement of Interest is on file with the Elections Department and <u>ALL</u> information has been provided in the spaces provided at the top of the petition.
- The candidate must <u>file at least the minimum number of signatures</u> required for the office sought and no more than the maximum number allowed. If there are too few, the Elections Director cannot accept the nomination petition(s).
- Check to see that the signature portion of each petition is complete:
  - o Is there a signature for each signer?
  - o Is there a printed name for each signature?
  - Actual residence address or description of place of residence; Arizona post office box address; city or town.
  - o Is there a date for each signature?
- Check to see that the circulator portion on the <u>back of each petition</u> is complete. Did the Circulator:
  - Print his/her name in **both** spaces provided.
  - Print the County in the space provided.
  - Sign his/her name in the space provided.
  - o Print the circulator's <u>actual residence address including city</u>, town and <u>zip code</u>.
